GRM Biowood is a propriety composite manufactured by combining wood waste, polymer and additives. This unique combination gives many of the tactile and aesthetic benefits of timber without some of the shortcomings. Biowood is stable, it does not crack, split or rot. Biowood is also water and termite resistant and does not promote the growth of mould or mildew. It is protected from fading by a factory applied UV resistant coating ensuring excellent colour retention and maximum service life.

Intergrain NaturalStain™ is a high performance, semi-transparent, water based stain designed to provide class leading protection from UV and transform the colour of exterior timber substrates. NaturalStain contains unique Hydroguard technology which adds protection to guard timber and composites against Australian and New Zealand harsh conditions as well as the abrasive effects of foot traffic. The advanced finish resists stain absorption helping the substrate stay clean. The result is a substrate that stays protected and looking fresh for longer.
